Student Guidance



What is the Student Ideas fund?

We're building a celebrated and lively community you can be proud to be a part of. If you have an **Idea** that hits one of the following, we want to hear from you:

- Improves the student experience
- Builds a sense of belonging
- Strengthens ties with local communities
- Promotes sustainability
- Shares your knowledge and skills

We have £40,000 to support student-led ideas! The Student Ideas Fund will provide the funds to bring your idea to life. This fund is open to all students! Whether you have a project as an **individual student**, **are a collective of students** looking for help getting the ball rolling or a **society** hosting something fresh we are here to support you!

The SIF aims to be as flexible as possible when supporting ideas! Your idea could be a **campaign!** A **Give it a Go** workshop you wish to run (even if you're not a society!) or a new initiative within your **faculty** or **society.** The SIF can provide funding to launch a new initiative, fund a one-off initiative, or help restart a stalled idea. Take a look at some of the previous ideas we have funded here!

Eligibility

As the Student Ideas Fund is made up of donations from alumni at The University of Leeds it must hit specific donor wishes. Therefore, the Student Ideas Fund has criteria outlined below:

- Ideas must align with one or more of the fund's objectives (see bullet points at the top)
- Projects can be one-time initiatives, new concepts, or a relaunch of stalled ideas
- Proposals must not duplicate existing funding opportunities or contravene UoL/LUU policies
- Funding excludes personal academic research, scholarships, and direct financial benefits to the applicant
- Proposals won't support projects which should be supported by existing or 'core' funding (e.g. the replacement of old equipment)

- Projects where other sources of funding are available or appropriate, including direct Service/School/Faculty funding won't be supported
- Projects that require several years of funding will only be funded for their initial launch or relaunch
- Staff and/or commission costs will not be funded.

Submit your idea

Fill out our initial idea form <u>here!</u> All you need to have ready for this form is a rough outline of your idea and the amount you are considering applying for. Please note we cannot provide more than £5000 per project.

Once we receive your initial idea, one of our team members will check if it is eligible. If it is, we will contact you to attend an application workshop and connect you with an LUU or University team to support you in completing the <u>main application</u> and ensure you gain expert advice and support in making your idea a reality. You can expect to hear back within two weeks of submission.

You will then submit your full application. This will be shared with Union and University staff to make recommendations on. You may receive suggestions to improve your application and will be provided with adequate support to make edits. Within three weeks of submitting your main application, you will hear back from the panel if it has approved or rejected your funding proposal.

Next Steps

If your Main SIF Application form is approved, you will be contacted regarding next steps and provided with more in detail guidance. Please see below summarised next steps to enable you a brief understanding of what can be expected.

- 1. You will be matched with a staff support to meet with and provide advice for your idea. This staff support will be your first port of call throughout the project timeline of your idea
- 2. You will receive the funding to support you with your idea
- 3. You will begin to complete your project tracker to help yourself and your staff support keep track of your project especially when it comes to things like expenses and key deadlines.
- 4. Once your project is completed you will be able to complete the impact report to highlight the impact your idea had on yourself and the community.

Application Timeline

*Dates may change depending on if funding runs out. Keep an eye on the website:

Wait time: 10 days

Staff check if your idea fits SIF criteria then they will email you.

Apply

Submit a main application.

Wait time: 2-3 weeks

Staff Approve, Pause or Reject your idea and provide feedback.

First Meeting

In your approval email, you will recieve three options for your first meeting. In this meeting, a member of the SIF team will run you through the expectations and you will meet your staff support.

Third Meeting

This will be your final meeting which will take place after your idea is completed. Here the staff will support you in completing your impact report and SIF feedback form.

Workshop

- Attend an optional support workshop to begin completion of main application.
- Workshops will be held based on demand.
- Typically, they will be on Wednesdays at 10-11am in Crossroads
- You must sign up to a workshop to attend.

Second Meeting

Depending on the turn around of your project, you may not need a second meeting. If you do, you should arrange to meet with your staff support around the half way mark of your project for a check in.

31st August

Your idea will have been completed, all money spent and your impact report and feedback form submitted. You may finish your project before then and that's absolutely fine!
