# Impact In Action

## Rainbow Laces

Varsity is the most exciting sporting event of the year, where we see the University of Leeds and Leeds Beckett go head-to-head across 60+ different sporting fixtures in 3 days, closing with the Rugby Finale at Headingley Stadium. This is a key time of year when LUU has a direct impact on its Clubs and Societies.

★ 850+ participants from LUU sports teams

★ 129 student volunteers

In 2025, we championed inclusion through the Rainbow Laces Campaign, encouraging teams to make sport welcoming for everyone. By distributing rainbow-coloured shoelaces and arranging awareness activities, we helped LGBTQ+ students feel seen, safe, and able to take part in LUU sports. Varsity became a celebration of diversity and support, and amplified LUU's commitment to equality and ultimate goal to create a truly inclusive sporting community.

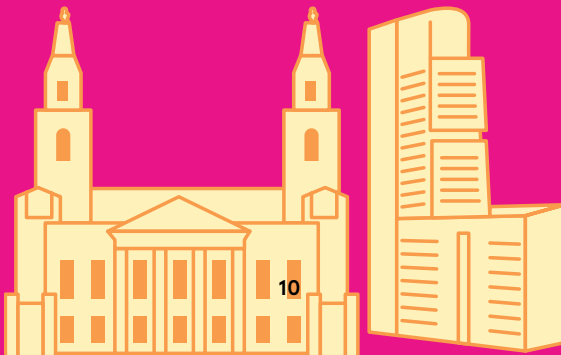

# New Initiatives for 2025

- ★ We opened our Liberation Hub, a dedicated space for students to celebrate identity, culture and community.
- ★ We partnered with SASHA to develop 'SASHA Accreditation,' a network and training programme supporting Clubs and Societies to help students and prevent sexual assault and harrassment. This autumn, we celebrated our first SASHA Accredited society - LUU Men's Rugby Union.
- ★ We launched Gryphons Get Active, a programme of work to help students to become physically active - focused on supporting women, people of colour and postgraduate students.
- ★ We have committed to becoming an Endo-Friendly Union and Employer, working to destigmatize and address women's health by making necessary amendments for employees dealing with related conditions.

# Work in the Wider Community

**'It's amazing to have that influence at a national level'**

The Renters' Rights Bill passed into law in the summer of 2025. These improvements came after local MP, Alex Sobel, attended LUU's Let's Talk About event in 2023. This means limitations to upfront rent payments, strengthened housing standards for student accommodation, and enforced protections against tenancy rent increases.

**'When music is paired with kindness and inclusivity, the impact is very special'**

LUU Music Impact in the Community have made it their goal to do outreach work across different communities, to promote wellbeing through musical engagement. This past year, they have worked in dementia wards, care homes, hospices and with asylum seekers.

**'I couldn't be more proud'**

LUU Athletics is a society for athletes of all abilities. In November, a former member of the society, Grace Nevens, unfortunately passed away, which shocked and saddened their community. In her memory, the society raised £25,000 through fundraising with MIND.

**'We leave every surf spot in a better condition than when we found it'**

Leeds Surf Society have a very key focus on sustainability, collaborating with Surfers Against Sewage in order to conduct countless beach clean-ups in popular spots such as Newcastle, Newquay and even Morocco!

**'ISoc has enriched the university experience while prioritising faith and well-being'**

Leeds Islamic Society is a hub for Muslim students at university in Leeds, aiming to foster community, spiritual growth and social impact. ISoc have worked closely with LUU and the University, ensuring the safety and representation of Muslim students, providing a Muslim Student Advisor for wellbeing.

LUU maintains strong expertise in student needs and priorities through our insight gathering processes. In 2025, we produced and published 37 reports on the student experience. These included papers presented at University meetings such as Council, Senate and TSEB, Social Outcomes surveys with our Insight Panel, pulse surveys for our student staff, literature reviews, and wide-scale surveys for our Strategic Review.



# Three Years of Growth at Leeds
